COOPERATION AGREEMENT

Between:

The Haifa District Committee of the Israel Bar Association, Israel

And:

The Munich Bar (chamber of lawyers in the District of the Munich Higher Regional Court), Bavaria, Germany

The Parties shall be related to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party".

PREAMBLE

The Parties wish to promote friendly relations, mutual understanding and cooperation of the Bar members in the districts of the Parties, in order to enable members of the Parties to establish and improve relations within the legal profession on personal and professional levels.

Therefore, the Parties have agreed as follows:

1

Exchange of Information

The Parties shall exchange information on an on-going basis with regard to current developments in the legal profession in their respective countries.

2

Improving Knowledge

The Parties shall promote the exchange of their members' knowledge about their respective country's culture, legal systems, legal professions, legal practice and legal basic and continuing training of the members. In particular, the Parties shall enhance the knowledge of their members with regard to the rules of professional ethics, the lawyers' system of self-administration and the legal systems of both countries.

Joint Activities

The Parties declare their willingness to organize joint events in order to introduce the legal practice and judicial proceedings of each Party to members of the other Party.

Reciprocal Exchange Programs

The Parties shall organize visits of each Party's members, with emphasis on young lawyers, in the other Party's country.

Supporting Measures

The Parties Intend to enhance and intensify their cooperation in every aspect. In order to do so, all means of communication shall be used and further developed.
